

Scouting and refugees: Aid or impact? **Both!**

CONTENT AND DURATION:

1. We will analyse **examples of ongoing scout activities with refugee children and young adults** particularly in Turkey, FYROM, Serbia and Germany (see also on Europak and scout.org) and we will particularly go in deep with the Greek and the Turkish cases- 20 minutes
2. **Q&A** – 10 Minutes
3. Based on three kind of countries (A. border countries to crisis areas – for example Turkey and Israel; B. transit countries – for example Italy, Greece, FYROM and Serbia; C. final destination countries – for example Germany and Sweden) we will then discuss the **short, medium and long term approach of scouting & guiding to both migrants and refugees** identifying when scouting & guiding can only aid and when it can (and must) have impact on our communities, on our NSOs/MOs and on the migrants/refugees. Every participant can bring in his/her experience, to discuss the topics we presented and also ask any questions that may arise during the debate. – 60 minutes
4. **Follow up**, during which we will have the opportunity to follow up on any conclusions reached during the discussions + we share SHP foreign volunteers request. – 15 minutes
